## Training in cultural mapping: a support to civil society actors for the better management of Mediterranean cultural heritage

A training workshop on **Cultural Mapping** will take place on **17-19 June 2010 in Nicosia, Cyprus**, within **Euromed Heritage 4**, a programme funded by the European Union.

Cultural mapping is gaining widespread recognition as an important tool for cultural heritage management and for enhancing public participation and appropriation of heritage.

This workshop will introduce about 40 civil society actors to a range of cultural mapping methods and applications, from well-established procedures to cutting-edge practice, and open up the discussion to consider its usefulness as a tool, and how it might be incorporated into their current and future practice.

The workshop will provide examples of practice from around the region, in particular from Nicosia where actions from previous phases of Euromed Heritage programme are maintained in current activities, and that demonstrate good practice in both cultural mapping applications and project sustainability.

This workshop is organised in **cooperation with London Metropolitan University and University of Nicosia**.
